ONLINE FORUM FOR WRITERS, STUDENTS, AND TEACHERS OF HAIKU

As part of the 2006 ukiaHaiku Festival, Jane Reichhold, judge of the 2005 and 2006 Adult Contemporary Haiku category, has created an online forum for all those interested in writing, learning about, and teaching haiku.

This forum is open to the public, and is free of charge. It is sponsored by AHA Poetry, a production of Jane Reichhold, on behalf of the Poet Laureate Committee of Ukiah, which produces the ukiaHaiku Festival.

In the forum, registered participants will be able to read tutorials about haiku prepared by Ms. Reichhold, submit haiku for feedback, provide feedback on other haiku posted at the forum, share ideas for haiku curriculum, and meet others interested in the genre.

To register:

- 1) Online, go to: <http://www.ahapoetry.com/> and choose the link for *AHA Poetry Forum* (third item in list). This will take you to: <http://haikuhut.com/JaneReichhold/index.php>, which is the AHA Poetry Forum.
- 2) Under the "Welcome" section at the top of the page, click on "AHA Poetry Forum."
- 3) Read through the "Welcome" and "Guidelines" then "How to Register for Membership" to familiarize yourself with the forum.
- 4) Click on "Register" at the top of the page.
- 5) Read through and approve the terms of usage, and you will be guided through registration.
- 6) Once registered, from the main page, go down to the bottom of the page (scroll) and under "Teacher's Forum," choose "Workshop for Teaching Japanese Genres."
- 7) Once inside the forum, you can read at random, post replies, questions, poems, send and receive E-mail with other registered users either publicly or privately.
